Resources for Community-Based Seniors Organizations serving Veterans in Alberta

Key Programs and Supports

Here is a list of and key programs and supports for veterans. This may be valuable when you are working with older veterans, to help promote awareness about supports available to them.

Government of Alberta

- The <u>Veterans Service Centre</u> is a centre in Edmonton where veterans can find financial, employment, housing and crisis supports.
- The <u>Operational Stress Injury Clinic</u> is an Alberta Health Services clinic that offers mental health services for veterans, Canadian Forces members, RCMP members, and their families.
- The <u>Alex Decoteau Award of Honour</u> is a Government of Alberta scholarship of \$5,000 for CAF members, veterans, and their families to pursue post-secondary education.

Government of Canada

- <u>Veterans Affairs Canada</u> has a mandate to support all veterans. Their website offers information about varied supports for veterans including:
 - Veterans Independence Program The Veterans Independence Program provides annual tax-free funding for services such as ground maintenance, housekeeping, meal preparation, and professional health and support services.
 - <u>Long-term Care</u> All health systems in Canada provide some level of long-term care support in provincially licensed or regulated facilities. This resource provide helpful links to support seniors looking for long-term care facilities.
 - Mental Health supports Mental Health resources offered by Veterans Affairs.

Non-profit Organizations

- VETS Canada is a large non-profit organization that provides support services to veterans in need across Canada.
- <u>The Royal Canadian Legion</u> offers a variety of different programs for veterans including some specifically for older veterans. There are service branches across the province.
- Homes for Heroes creates villages for veterans that consist of 15-25 tiny homes arranged in a park-like setting.
 There is a veterans village located in Edmonton and in Calgary.
- Veteran's Association Food Bank offers support at their <u>Calgary location</u> and their <u>Edmonton location</u>.
