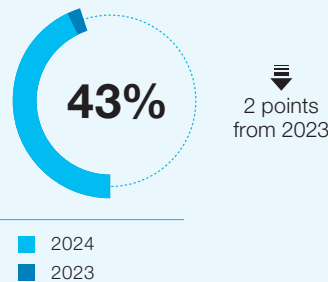

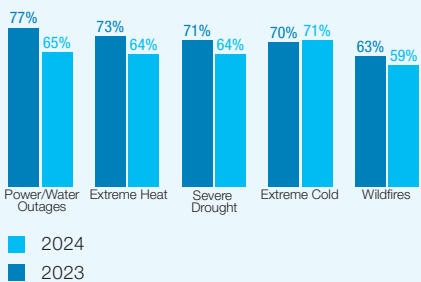

Top 5 hazards of concern in Alberta

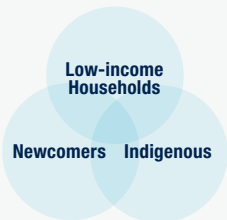


Self-reliance continues to be the leading motivator for preparedness action in Alberta, closely followed by the desire to protect loved ones.

Reasons for not being prepared continue to be:

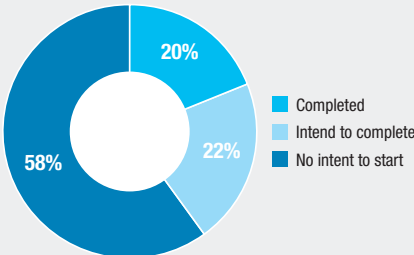
- Need more information

Those who may need more support to prepare:

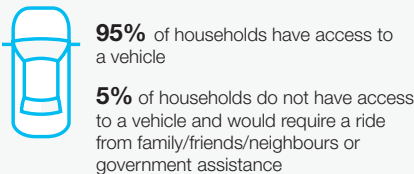


Mitigation at home
