

As well, for some sections of this Guide (e.g., Housekeeping, Lawn Care & Snow Removal, etc.), many organizations and/or businesses exist in Calgary and surrounding area. In these cases, we randomly selected, called, and where appropriate, included these organizations and/or businesses in the Guide. Our aim was to provide a representative, rather than an exhaustive, listing of the organizations and/or businesses serving older adults that are available in Calgary and surrounding area.

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FINANCIAL PROGRAMS & BENEFITS



Federal Benefits

Canadian Pension Plan (CPP)

The CPP is a retirement pension that is a monthly taxable benefit that is intended to replace part of an individual's income when they retire. To be eligible, applicants must be at least 60 years old, and have made at least one valid contribution to the CPP. The CPP is not automatic and must be applied for in advance of when the applicant wants the CPP pension to start. The amount of benefit available is based on the applicant's average earnings throughout their working life, the applicant's contributions to the CPP, and the age at which the applicant decides to start their CPP retirement pension. Applicants can choose to receive the CPP as early as 60 years of age or as late as 70 years of age. In addition to the CPP, applicants may be eligible for other CPP benefits including the Post-Retirement Benefit, Disability Pension, Post-Retirement Disability Pension, Survivor's Pension, Children's Benefit, and Death Benefit. These additional benefits also must be applied for. Applications can be mailed or submitted online through an individual's My Service Canada Account.

Old Age Security (OAS)

OAS is a monthly pension that is available to eligible adults 65 years of age and older who meet Canadian legal status and residence requirements. For eligibility, if an individual is living in Canada, they must be a Canadian citizen or legal resident and must have resided in Canada for at least 10 years since the age of 18. If an individual is living outside of Canada, they must have been a Canadian citizen or legal resident on the day before the individual left Canada and have resided in Canada for at least 20 years since the age of 18. The amount of benefit available is based on how long the applicant has lived in Canada after the age of 18. Individual becomes eligible in exchange for a higher monthly amount. Choosing to defer the OAS pension may impact eligibility for provincial financial benefits. Service Canada has implemented a process to automatically enrolled, Service Canada will mail the individual a notification letter the month following their 64th birthday. If an individual has not received a letter from Service Canada, they must apply in writing for the OAS pension.

Old Age Security (OAS) (continued)

In addition to the OAS pension, there are three types of OAS benefits: the Guaranteed Income Supplement, the Allowance, and the Allowance for the Survivor.

Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)

The GIS provides a monthly non-taxable benefit to OAS pension recipients who are lowincome and are living in Canada. To be eligible, applicants must be receiving the OAS pension and must have an annual income below the maximum annual income threshold.

Allowance

The Allowance is a benefit available to low-income individuals 60 to 64 years of age who are the spouse or common-law partner of a GIS recipient. To be eligible, the applicant must be 60 to 64 years of age, a Canadian citizen or legal resident, reside in Canada or have resided in Canada for at least 10 years since the age of 18, the spouse or partner receives an OAS pension and is eligible for the GIS, and applicant and spouse or common-law partner's annual combined income is less than the maximum allowable annual threshold.

Allowance for the Survivor

The Allowance is a benefit available to low-income individuals aged 60 to 64 years whose spouse or common-law partner has died. To be eligible, the applicant must be 60 to 64 years of age, a Canadian citizen or legal resident, reside in Canada or have resided in Canada for at least 10 years since the age of 18, the spouse or common-law partner has died and the applicant has not remarried or entered into a common-law relationship, and the applicant's annual income is less than the maximum allowable annual threshold.

Provincial Benefits

Alberta Aids to Daily Living (AADL)

AADL is a cost-share program that assists individuals with a long-term disability and/or chronic or terminal illness in maintaining independence in their communities. AADL provides funding for basic medical equipment and supplies to meet clinically assessed needs. An assessment to determine equipment and supplies is required by an approved authorizer and equipment and supplies must be purchased from an approved vendor. A list of approved vendors is available on the website above. Clients pay 25% of the benefit cost up to \$500 per individual or family per benefit year. Low-income Albertans and individuals receiving income assistance are exempt from paying the cost-sharing portion. For more information, please call and/or visit the website above.

Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH)

The AISH program provides a monthly living allowance, a child benefit, personal benefits, and health benefits for adults under 65 years of age who have a permanent disability that severely limits their ability to earn a living. Applicants must also be living in Alberta, be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, and meet financial eligibility criteria. Individuals who are receiving or are eligible to receive Old Age Security (OAS) benefits are not eligible for AISH. AISH clients may be eligible to receive up to a maximum monthly living allowance of \$1,685 depending on their partner's income. AISH clients living in a facility (i.e., a nursing home) may be eligible to receive a maximum monthly modified living allowance (Modified AISH). The Modified AISH consists of an accommodation rate plus a maximum personal allowance of \$322. The amount received will depend on the incomes of the applicant and their cohabiting partner. Residential Access Modification Program (RAMP)

RAMP provides grants to help low-income Albertans with mobility challenges modify their homes so they can enter and move around more easily. To be eligible, applicants must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident who has lived in Alberta for 90 continuous days and must meet financial eligibility criteria. Applicants also must reside at the address for which the grant is being applied for and must expect to reside at that address for a period of 10 continuous years after application approval.

Residential Access Modification Program (RAMP) (continued)

In addition, applicants must meet **one** of the following mobility criteria:

- An individual of any age who requires the use of a wheelchair on a permanent basis;
- An adult 65 years of age and older who uses a four-wheeled walker on a permanent basis; or
- An individual diagnosed with a progressive neurodegenerative disease.

Applicants must also meet income eligibility thresholds (i.e., a single person with a gross household income of \$36,900 or a couple with \$46,500 or less). Eligible modifications must enable the applicant to enter or move within their own living space. The modifications usually must be permanent (requests for temporary modifications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis) and must be made to properties in Alberta. Seniors Financial Assistance Program

The Seniors Financial Assistance Program is a collection of supports for adults 65 years of

age and older provided by the Government of Alberta to supports for adults of years of age and older provided by the Government of Alberta to supplement federal financial assistance programs. Supports include the Alberta Seniors Benefit, the Special Needs Assistance for Seniors, the Dental and Optical Assistance for Seniors, Health Coverage for Seniors, the Seniors Property Tax Deferral Program, and the Seniors Home Adaptation and Repair Program. To be eligible, individuals must be 65 years of age and older, have lived in Alberta for at least 3 months immediately before applying, and be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident. Individuals should receive a Seniors Financial Assistance application in the mail 6 months prior to their 65th birthday. After completing and submitting a Seniors Financial Assistance application form, applicants are automatically assessed for the Alberta Seniors Benefit, the Special Needs Assistance for Seniors, the Dental and Optical Assistance for Seniors, and Health Coverage for Seniors programs. The Seniors Property Tax Deferral Program and the Seniors Home Adaptation and Repair Programs must be applied for separately. Alberta Seniors Benefit

The Alberta Seniors Benefit provides eligible older adults with a monthly benefit to supplement benefits from federal programs. In addition to the eligibility criteria for the Seniors Financial Assistance Program (see above), applicants must be receiving the Old Age Security (OAS) Pension and must meet financial eligibility criteria.

Alberta Seniors Benefit (continued)

The amount of benefit which an applicant is eligible to receive is determined by the applicant's income (combined with a spouse/partner's income, regardless of age, if applicable), accommodation category, and marital/cohabitation status. A Supplementary Accommodation Benefit is available for eligible older adults who reside in a designated supportive living or long-term care facility. Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program

The Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program is a financial assistance program for eligible low-income older adults to help with the cost of specific health and personal supports and certain furniture and appliances. In addition to the eligibility criteria for the Seniors Financial Assistance Program (see the previous page), applicants must meet financial eligibility criteria. The amount of benefit which an applicant is eligible to receive is determined by the applicant's income (combined with a spouse/partner's income, regardless of age, if applicable), accommodation category, and marital/cohabitation status. The maximum assistance available in a benefit year is \$5,105. Please visit the website above for more information on specific maximums for the different health and personal supports, furniture, and appliances. Eligible supports are funded at primary or secondary income levels. Eligible health supports include items such as CPAP machines, diabetic supplies, nutritional beverages, orthotics, podiatry, and prescription costs. Eligible personal supports include bed bug treatments, celiac groceries, clothing, funeral expenses, home clean up, housekeeping and/or yard maintenance, laundry costs, lift chairs, medical trips, medical administration fees, personal response services, relocation of a washer and dryer, respite care, utility disconnection, and wigs. Dental and Optical Assistance for Seniors Program

The Dental and Optical Assistance for Seniors Program will reimburse eligible older adults for select dental and optical services. In addition to the eligibility criteria for the Seniors Financial Assistance Program (see the previous page), applicants must be receiving the Old Age Security (OAS) pension and meet financial eligibility criteria. Please visit the website above for partial and complete coverage income thresholds for singles and couples. Dental services are covered up to a maximum of \$5,000 every 5 years and include diagnostic, preventative, and restorative services, extractions, root canals, procedures relating to gum disease, and dentures.

Dental and Optical Assistance for Seniors Program (continued)

Services that are not eligible for coverage include bridges, crowns, braces, implants, fluoride treatment, teeth bleaching, and inlays. Optical services are covered up to a maximum of \$230 every 3 years and include prescription eyeglasses including lenses and frames dispensed by a recognized optical provider. Services that are not eligible for coverage include contact lenses, eye surgery, eye exams, accessories, magnifying devices, eye medication, non-prescription sunglasses, and reading glasses not dispensed by an optical provider. Health Coverage for Seniors Program

The Health Coverage for Seniors Program provides adults 65 years of age and older a premium-free benefit for coverage for prescriptions and other health-related services not covered under the Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP). Alberta Blue Cross administers the Health Coverage for Seniors program and manages claims, and the AHCIP manages eligibility and registration. To be eligible, individuals must provide proof of being 65 years of age and older. Eligible benefits include prescription drugs (70% coverage; individuals are required to pay the 30% co-payment to a maximum of \$25 with some exceptions), diabetic supplies (for insulin-treated diabetes only), ambulance services, clinical psychological services, home nursing care, and chiropractic services. Please note: Effective March 1, 2020, family members younger than 65 years of age will no longer be covered under the Health Coverage for Seniors Program.

Seniors Home Adaptation and Repair Program (SHARP)

SHARP allows eligible older adults to apply for a low-interest home equity loan from the Government of Alberta to cover repairs, adaptations, and/or renovations to their primary residence. The intent is to help older adults remain safe and independent in their homes, adapt and modify their homes to improve accessibility and mobility, and/or improve the energy efficiency of their homes. To be eligible, applicants must have an annual income of \$75,000 or less, be 65 years of age and older, be an Alberta resident, having lived in the province for at least 3 months, and own a residential property in Alberta which must be the applicant's primary residence. Applicants must have a minimum of 25% equity in the home. SHARP provides a maximum loan of up to \$40,000. The loan can be repaid at any time but will automatically become due when the applicant sells their home, is no longer the registered owner, or the home is no longer their primary residence. Seniors Property Tax Deferral Program

The Seniors Property Tax Deferral Program allows eligible older adult homeowners to apply to defer all or part of their annual residential property taxes through a low-interest home equity loan from the Government of Alberta. The Government of Alberta will pay the residential property taxes directly to the municipality on behalf of the homeowner. To be eligible, applicants must be 65 years of age and older, be an Alberta resident, having lived in the province for at least 3 months, and own a residential property in Alberta which must be the applicant's primary residence. Applicants must have a minimum of 25% equity in the home. The loan can be repaid at any time but will automatically become due when the applicant sells their home, is no longer the registered owner, or the home is no longer their primary residence. The Senior Support program provides up to two hours of assistance with light housekeeping and laundry every two weeks to eligible seniors. To qualify, individuals must be 65 years of age and older, eligible for the Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program, unable to do their own housekeeping, be renting from a non-family member, and have a household income under \$22,900 for a single individual or \$36,135 for couples. This program is available on a sliding fee scale based on the individual's annual income.

The City of Calgary's Seniors Services Home Maintenance provides eligible low-income older adults with basic yard care, snow removal, house cleaning, interior and exterior painting, and minor repairs. To qualify, individuals must be 65 years of age and older, unable to do basic house or yard work, are without family, community, or other home maintenance service, and have a household income under \$25,921 for a single individual, or \$32,270 for a couple. Eligible older adults are placed on a wait list for service and an assessment of need determines priority for service. For house cleaning, yard, and snow removal services, service cost recovery for clients eligible for the Alberta Seniors Benefit, Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program are direct billed to the Government of Alberta on the client's behalf.

JFSC Home Support program focuses on helping individuals with physical and/or emotional limitations that impact activities of daily living to help them remain as independent as possible and provide the supports to assist them to successfully age in place. The program provides older adults with assistance for in-home housekeeping duties such as cleaning of washrooms, kitchens, and floors, as well as assistance with laundry and cleaning dishes. There is a fee associated with the program which is assessed on an individual basis.

Eligible older adults are placed on a wait list for service and an assessment of need determines priority for service. For house cleaning, yard, and snow removal services, cost recovery for clients eligible for Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program is direct billed to the Government of Alberta on the client's behalf.

For an individual to be considered eligible for home collection, they must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Patient has a mental health problem that prevents them from leaving their residence;
- Patient has a dementia or brain injury that presents a safety risk while travelling;
- Patient has a medical condition in which a trip of an hour or more outside of the home would compromise their health; or
- Patient has high oxygen requirements that cannot be safely met with portable oxygen.

Home collections must be requested by the individual's physician and requisition forms must be faxed directly to Calgary Laboratory Services. Patients who do not meet the criteria for home collection may go to any community collection site. Individuals who are able to use Calgary Transit Access or other means of transportation are encouraged to use the patient collection sites as they are all wheelchair accessible (with the exception of the **Gulf** location; see next page).
