

How to Connect with Other CORE Members

Go to <https://corealberta.ca/> and [log in](#) through the upper right-hand corner. If you are not a CORE member, you can [sign up](#) for a free membership. Please read the guide on **How to Become a CORE Member** if you have questions.


To connect with other CORE members, you must be a member of a CORE group. To join a CORE Group, please read the guide on **How to Join a CORE Group**. After logging in, you will see the option for **My Groups**.




If you have an Invite Code for a group, you can enter that code into this field.



Otherwise, if you continue down, you can see the groups that you have joined. You can see that for the Social Connection, Wellness, and Mental Health CORE Group, there is a checkmark beside the word **Joined**.



Click on **Go** to view the group and its menu. You can click on **Members** to see who else belongs to the group.



You can see the names of people who are part of the group, including the **Group Managers**. Feel free to browse through and read the profiles of other members whom you may want to connect with.

PRIVATE MESSAGES

When you are on the members page of a group you belong to, you will see the option to send a **Private Message** to another CORE member.



When you click on **Private Message**, you will be taken to a page where you can compose your message to that member.






If at any time you would like to retrieve your messages, you can click on the **MSG** icon at the top of the CORE page.
